## National agency for promoting French higher education abroad

In 1998 the French government founded an organization called the EduFrance Agency to promote French higher education abroad.

- ◆ In 2007, EduFrance became CampusFrance.
- ◆ CampusFrance is placed under the supervision of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs, the Ministry of Higher Education and Research and the Ministry of Immigration, Integration, National Identity and Co-development.
- ◆ CampusFrance is dedicated to promoting international mobility for students, academics and researchers.



Under the supervision of ministerial authorities and in conjunction with higher education institutions and their official conferences,

CampusFrance aims to:

- ◆ Promote French higher education programmes throughout the world.
- ◆ Offer international students a path to success via higher education in France.
- ◆ Assist international students beginning with their first enquiries made in their home countries to their actual stay in France and ending with the trip home to their countries of origin.
- ◆ In association with other stakeholders, CampusFrance is creating a Quality Charter for all international students.






In order to fulfil its mission, CampusFrance works in association with all higher education institutions, and more particularly with its member institutions.

In 2009, CampusFrance has 227 member institutions, including:

- ◆ Most universities and PRES (research and academic clusters),
- ◆ 13 Grandes Ecoles and 61 engineering schools,
- ◆ 42 business schools,
- ◆ Specialized schools, including 20 art schools and French language schools.

227 member organisations of CampusFrance (June 2009)



- 79 universities and 3 PRES
- 13 Grandes Ecoles
- 61 engineering schools
- 42 business schools
- 35 specialised schools (language, art, tourism...)

CampusFrance has established 113 offices in 88 countries.

- ◆ CampusFrance offices aim primarily at providing assistance to international students interested in study programmes in France, from the initial information seeking to university pre-enrolment.
- ◆ In connection with CampusFrance Paris, which organizes major promotional events such as education fairs in host countries, CampusFrance offices also promote French higher education at local universities.
- ◆ CampusFrance offices are run by personnel trained by CampusFrance in close association with the supervising ministries and the official conferences.

### Objectives : enhance academic mobility and cooperations between HEIs

The CampusFrance programme of events abroad (education fairs, forums, thematic visits, university tours), which draw on average 150,000 visitors per year, is conceived in close consultation with the supervising authorities and the higher education institutions along with their official conferences.

- ◆ CampusFrance organizes education fairs in conjunction with major international events (cultural exchange programmes, universal exhibitions, commemorations).
- ◆ CampusFrance has experimented a number of new concepts, such as thematic university tours, specialized networking sessions, workshops on academic innovation and the promotion of doctoral programmes.



Over the past years, CampusFrance has developed activities in the field of European exchanges:

- ◆ CampusFrance has been responding to calls for tender launched by the European Commission.
- ◆ CampusFrance is coordinator for projects and participates to activities, mainly in the field of higher education promotion, information and cooperation.
- ◆ CampusFrance has carried out numerous studies and analyses.
- ◆ CampusFrance has developed exchanges with its European counterparts (DAAD, British Council, Nuffic, etc.).



Designed especially for international students, the CampusFrance website can be consulted in over twenty languages.

- ◆ It allows easy access to all the information needed for preparing one's studies in France, from choosing one's study programme via the online catalogue, to arriving in France.
- ◆ In order to better respond to local demand, 53 country-specific websites have been developed on the basis of a model defined by CampusFrance.

In 2009, it recorded over three million visitors.


